WHAT TO BRING

- Drawstring type backpack, lightweight that you wouldn't mind losing
- Swim suit/towel for water activities
 - ◇ **Note:** *one-piece swimsuits or tankinis where the top and bottom touch at waist are acceptable for girls. A dark colored shirt must be worn over two-piece swimsuits where top and bottom do not touch at the waist*
 - ◇ *Shirts must be worn at all times to/from pool and water slide areas by both boys and girls*
- Sunscreen
- Water bottle – Please mark the bottle with the student's name
- Snacks/water
- Some extra spending money for snacks at the Sky Cafe
- Bible (with student's name and address in it) and pen/pencil to take notes

MEDICAL EMERGENCIES

Our medical team is comprised of all professional emergency medical personnel who are trained in all aspects of emergency medicine and advanced life support. They are capable of delivering on the spot treatments, first aid and comprehensive emergency medical care.

MEDICATION

Students **must** drop off their medications at check-in. During the bus ride to and from event, the medical team will follow the buses in order to administer medicine in cases of a medical emergency.

Students will need to come to the medical station at the appropriate times during the day to receive medications. If they forget (which we know teenagers do) our medical staff will track down the student to give them their medicine.

SECURITY

We have thoughtfully considered and established all of our policies and procedures to keep every student safe while they are in our care. We are bringing our own security team, composed of volunteers.

TRANSPORTATION

We will be traveling to United Road Trip on chartered buses. Buses will be split between guys and girls to the best of our ability.

All buses are pre-assigned by group/friends requested. We will have staff members and adult leaders spread throughout each bus. We will show rated G or PG only movies on the buses. Once on the bus, students will not be allowed back off the bus until arrival.

All of our buses will be not free so please keep this in mind when packing bus snacks.

SMALL GROUPS

The leaders in your student's small group will be background checked and trained by the campus Student Pastors. Small groups are campus specific and generally range from 10-12 students plus adult leaders. Small group time is for discussion on the topics the speaker teaches on during worship sessions.

ROAD TRIP RULES

CHECK-IN INSTRUCTIONS

Middle school day is SATURDAY, October 15 | High school day is SUNDAY, October 16

- Check-in is at 7 AM at the Town East campus.
- Forney, N. Dallas, LP Español N. Dallas, Town East and White Rock students will ALL check in at Town East. **There will be NO check-in at the other campuses.**
- As you arrive at the church, park in front of the building (see attached map). Do not park in the coned off areas as the buses will be loading there!
- **Leave your student's luggage in the car.**
- Enter the building from the front side (see attached check-in map)
- As you enter the building, you will pick up their nametag in The Clubhouse. (To the right of the front doors)
- Once a student receives their nametag, proceed to the designated medicine check-in location (all medication MUST be checked in except inhalers) Please DO NOT bring over-the-counter medications.
- If dropping off meds, parent **must** fill out and sign a medication card and all medication **MUST** be in the original prescription bottle.
- Once medicine has been checked in (or if none), student may get their luggage and get on their assigned bus. Bus assignments will be located on your student's nametag.
- Once a student loads onto the bus, they will stay on the bus until departure, so be sure to encourage your student to use the restroom and give your goodbye hugs BEFORE they load onto the bus.

Upon return, all medications can be picked up at the table outside of the main doors

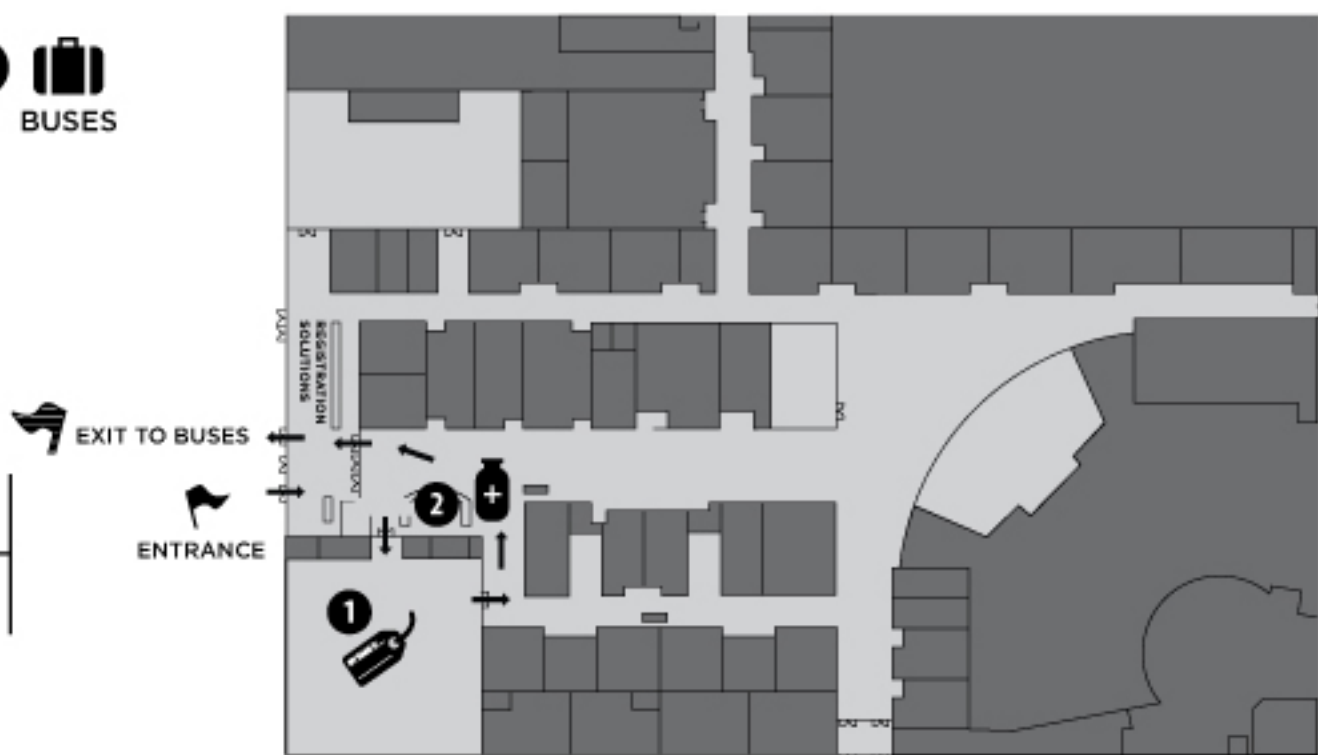
- Park in main lot.
