Lakepointe Church—Rockwall, TX

- Created prayer teams for weekly services and major events with up to 150 volunteers, training and equipping them to lead events of 20,000 people in prayer.
- Organized and coordinated all baptisms for the main campus with up to 25 baptisms per weekend by hearing each salvation story, guiding each family theologically, and caring for them pastorally.
- Taught lessons on leadership and scripture by preparing with prayer and studying and used this to shepherd a weekly high school girls' small group with up to 25 members.
- Planned, facilitated, and led monthly worship experiences for 40 young adults and assisted in setting up and facilitating weekly student worship experiences for up to 1,000 students.
- Participated in evangelistic mission trips while learning and training under church plants, examining Japanese culture to learn cross-cultural evangelistic strategies, providing resources to fuel local ministry in Japan, and training 50 middle schoolers to plan and execute small mission projects.

- Facilitated a monthly new members class reaching 150 new church members each session, connecting them with their next step in following Jesus and guiding them to discover their giftings to serve.

- Led special events in worship, including weekly acoustic worship for a group of sexual assault victims at Liberty University by planning set lists, organizing volunteers, and leading with guitar and vocals.
- Mentored 3 small group leaders weekly, primarily focused on studying scripture, developing intimacy with Jesus and community, and giving feedback.
- Intense spiritual training weekly in spiritual formation, leadership, and mentor meetings including small group and 1-on-1 discipleship.
